


# Let's find out, all about me! Autumn 1

We will be learning how to re-tell a story using actions and signifiers. We will be learning to write our name, as well as using our phonic knowledge to write for a purpose such as labelling.

## **Maths**

This half term we will be learning to finish and create different patterns and learn about the numbers 0-4, understanding what the value of those numbers means.

## **Knowledge and Understanding**

We will be learning about what it means to be a member of the St Richards Family as well as our own families. We will be exploring weather and observing how it changes. We will be using our class story to talk about journeys.

## **Expressive Arts and Design**

We will be sketching self-portraits and exploring colour mixing. We will also be printing using shapes and learning to join materials together.


## **Key Vocabulary**

## Literacy

T4W: *The Enormous Turnip*

We will continue to re-tell a story using actions and signifiers.

We will be using our phonics knowledge to sequence and label our story and label a poster about an animal.

## Maths

This half term, continue from first half-term subitise within 5, perceptually and conceptually, depending on the arrangements. We will compare sets by matching, seeing that when every object in a set can be matched to one in the other set, they contain the same number and are equal amounts.

## Knowledge and Understanding

What does their home look like at Christmas, how might a Jewish home look preparing for Hannukah?

How do we celebrate birthdays, do we have the same or different traditions?

What happens to vegetables when we boil them (making soup)?

What gives us light?

Do all animals sleep at night?

## Expressive Arts and Design

We will be using, choosing and mixing paint colours . We will make observational drawings of different vegetables.

We will use air dry clay to make an ornament for a Christmas tree and use collage to decorate a photo frame.
